Christian greetings from the Philippines. November was a month of hitting the ground running since school had already started before we arrived. The first priority was getting into the Methods of Bible Study class that I am teaching at Immanuel Bible College.

Several Pathfinder construction projects are still on-going and some new ones were evaluated. The IBC canteen project done last July still needs the roofing painted and some electrical lines, receptacles, and lights installed. But, praise God, the canteen is operational at this time. One of the guest apartments needs a major overhaul with scraping, cleaning, and painting of walls, electrical work, plumbing, tile work, and demolition and rebuilding of the back rooms, replacing wooden rafters with metal and wood siding with block. The ministry pavilion in Dumaguete is being used but continuing to be improved with grill siding and doors for security. Also comfort rooms (restrooms) are needed and a security wall and gate.

Plans were changed for the Christmas camp we normally have in Dumaguete this year. It was to be just a one-day party on December 20, however, we were able to get three IBC students to come early and along with our Dumaguete Missionary Baptist Academy (DMBA) student, they worked with about fifty children for two days with drama, age level music and choral arrangements which were presented to other children and parents during the party. The team was rewarded with a dinner in town and after getting back to the house spent another two hours with the youth ministry.

On December 21st, the team headed to Siquijor Island to help Pastor Lydia at Christ Dominion church with her outreach to the children of Insanagan. The student team practiced presentations and songs with the Siquijor youth workers and led action and worship songs, games and presented a drama, before dinner and gifts were given out. Aprox 75 people attended with many more adult on-lookers.

At the end of December we are preparing to fly to Davao, in southern Mindanao to provide Royal Rangers training to leaders there and then resume classes at IBC on January 7th as well as preparing for mid-term exams, and initiate planning for VBS and Ranger camps in April and May.
